<u>FYI – Before You Commit</u>

- Membership in the Lakeside Academy Middle School National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) Chapter is open to rising 7th and 8th graders only. Students should apply at the end of their 6th or 7th grade year to participate during their 7th or 8th grade year.
- Students must maintain a minimum of a **3.8 GPA** to be accepted.
- NJHS meets the second Tuesday of each month after school until 3:20PM unless otherwise noted. Members are expected to make every effort to attend all meetings and participate in all NJHS activities.
- Students selected for membership will receive a CONTRACT and BY-LAWS to sign and return, finalizing their acceptance.
 - a. Please be aware that there is a **\$20** membership fee for NJHS. This helps pay for our national accreditation, a membership t-shirt, and any start-up materials for activities. Any additional money left over in the budget at the end of the year is donated to a charity selected by the members of Lakeside's NJHS. *This note is simply to make you aware, but please do not pay this now!* A link will be made available on SchoolPay once acceptance letters go out.
 - b. NJHS members are also required to complete at least 20 service hours by May of their 2025-2026 school year. The hours must be collected after May 2025 and before May of 2026. Hours collected before May 2025 will not be counted towards the 20 required hours.

The application must include:

- □ Calculated GPA chart
 - Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.8 to be accepted.
- □ Completed Service, Leadership, Character, and Citizenship sections in the application.
- □ Four teacher recommendation names/subject areas
- □ Applicant signature
- □ Parent signature

SCHOLARSHIP:

You must currently have a Grade Point Average of <u>3.8</u> to be accepted into NJHS. Below are the directions for calculating your GPA.

GPA Points

A = 4	Calculate your GPA based on your current (6 th or 7 th) grade level
B = 3	Q1-Q3 grades ONLY.
C = 2	<u>VI VO GIAUCS ONDI</u> .

Enter your grade in the grade column and put the corresponding points in the same column (for example, A/4) for **Quarters 1-3**. Add the number of points in each Quarter column and divide by the number of courses (7). This is your GPA for each quarter. Average the 3 GPA's and that is your overall GPA. *<u>Your GPA will be verified by the front office, so please be honest.</u>

You must have an overall **GPA of 3.8** or above and during the first three guarters the 2024-2025 school year to be considered for NJHS.

Once inducted, you must maintain at least a 3.5 GPA for each quarter.

SERVICE:
